ACCELERATING RETAIL

WH Smith will open 60+ shops in North America during the next 2 years. By 2028, the company expects to have 500+ stores, up from its current 341, mainly in airports...The Paper Store unveiled its new concept, Uncharted, in Oak Brook, IL. Additional locations are planned across the country in 2025...Amazon opened 8 Amazon Fresh stores on the East and West coasts over the past month...Costco plans openings in 4 states before the end of 2024...Jersey's Mike's has

been acquired by Blackstone. Financial terms were not made public. The deal will enable Jersey Mike's to accelerate expansion...Fitness apparel brand **Sweaty Betty** opened its 1st 2 brick-and-mortar US stores in Chicago and Washington, DC. The brand has shop-in-shop concessions with **Nordstrom** and Bloomingdale...Mango has reached 40 US stores and will add 2 more by the end of the year. It plans to add 20+ US stores in 2025... Academy Sports + Outdoors opened 5 stores, giving it a total of 298 stores in 19 states. The retailer plans 160-180 new stores in the next 5 years...Dollar General will open 575+ US stores in fiscal 2025 and remodel 2,250 stores. As of 11/1/24, the company operated 20,523 Dollar General, DG Market, DGX and Popshelf stores across the US...**Tractor Supply** plans to increase its count goal to 3,200 locations. It will open 90 namesake stores in 2025, and 10+ Petsense by Tractor Supply stores. As of Sept., the company operated 2,270 Tractor Supply stores in 49 states 205 Petsense by Tractor Supply stores in 23 states.....Aldi opened 9 stores in December in 9 states...**Primark** opened its 1st Texas store, giving it 29 US stores in 12 states. The retailer plans 5 more TX stores. It operates 450 stores globally...Honeygrow restaurant has secured leases in MA, MD, NJ, and PA, surpassing 50 locations in 8 states.

DECELERATING RETAIL

Kohl's will close its Stoughton, MA store early next year and lay off 77 workers...Foot Locker has closed dozens of locations, and by 2026 will have shuttered 275 US Foot Locker and 125 Champs Sports stores... Walgreens closed 58 locations in November. It will eventually close 1,200 stores... Federal judges blocked Kroger's \$24.6 billion acquisition of **Albertsons...Macy's** will close 150 underperforming stores between 2024 and 2026.

NEW ENGLAND RETAIL

Brooks Brothers opened a 3-story location at 109 Newbury St., more than 2 years after closing its store at the corner of Newbury and Berkeley St., where it had been since 1932... **PickleBOS** signed a lease for 26,000 s/f at Core Investments' "On The Dot" development on Dorchester Avenue. Pickle-BOS will open next summer with 11 indoor courts, pro shop, lounge, and event space...Mighty Squirrel Brewing Co. will open a taproom/kitchen at Arsenal Yards, Watertown...The Fresh Market will open 2 Boston-area locations this month in Framingham and Mansfield. The company has 160 stores in 22 states...Rockland Trust Co. and its parent company will acquire **Enterprise Bank and Trust**. The merger will close in the 2nd half of 2025. Rockland Trust is the 6th-largest bank in MA. Enterprise ranks No. 20....Ocean State Job Lot purchased Cumberland Crossing, No. Attleboro, MA and will open a store at a former Christmas Tree **Shops** location there. OSJL has 159 US stores.
